Dear Westport Families,

At its meeting last night, Monday, March 23, the Board of Education voted to cancel the first four days of spring vacation. As a result, Monday, April 6; Tuesday, April 7; Wednesday, April 8; and Thursday, April 9, will be regular school days, with instruction delivered remotely. As previously scheduled, school will be closed on Good Friday, April 10. Attached, please find a copy of the updated school calendar.

Given the likelihood that Governor Lamont will close Connecticut Public Schools beyond March 31, and in consultation with Mark Cooper, Director of Health for the Westport Weston Health District, the Westport Public Schools (School Buildings) will remain closed until at least April 20, 2020. During this period of time school will be conducted on a remote basis. Within the next few days, we will be sending out updated information with respect to our distance learning plan.

In the interim, I hope that you and your families are safe and healthy.
