

Tools For Schools (TFS)/Indoor Air Quality (IAQ)
Did You Know...?
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Did you know...that all schools in the district have a Tools for Schools (TFS) Team made up of at least one administrator, teacher, school nurse, head custodian and parent? The TFS teams meet at least twice per year at each school (in the fall and spring) to have a meeting and do a walkthrough of the building to check for any potential Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) issues such as moisture incursion, odors, mold growth, cleanliness issues, evidence of pests, air flow (ventilation) issues, thermal comfort issues, etc. The team records the findings on a walkthrough spreadsheet and minutes are taken at each meeting. These documents, which are the running IAQ record for each building, are kept in a TFS binder at each school either in the nurse's office or administrator's office together with the TFS kit.

We already did our fall 2019 meetings and walkthroughs in October. We are now in the process finalizing all of the meeting minutes and walkthrough spreadsheets for each school.
